The Power of Choice is a unique substance misuse prevention program featuring Prime for Life[™] curriculum. Prime for Life[™] is an evidence-based curriculum based on 30+ years of research that focuses on prevention of alcohol and drug misuse by changing beliefs, attitudes, and perception of risk. Participants are empowered to identify their values and given clear tools to make low-risk choices to protect what they value.
